



How to get to us

By Train

Travel from London, Paris, Amsterdam, Lille, Cologne and other major European cities connecting to the excellent French high speed TGV (Train à Grande Vitesse) rail service run by SNCF. There are three train stations within a half an hour drive from La Bastide Sainte Anne :

AvignonTGV on the Marseilles line is about 20 minutes from La Bastide Sainte Anne, this large modern station is the closest and most convenient with a bar, cafe and newsagent;

Avignon Centre again about 30 minutes from La Bastide Sainte Anne, this is the old central station used mainly for local slow trains and, for customs reasons, for the direct London-Avignon service.

Nîmes on the Perpignan and Montpellier line at about half an hour from La Bastide Sainte Anne.

Remoulins is local station which is only 5 minutes drive from La Bastide Sainte Anne

Travel by train from London to Avignon is especially simple during the summer, as from July to September Eurostar offer a direct service between London to Avignon Centrale. At other times Eurostar runs fast direct services from London and Ashford to Paris and Lille, which connect to the TGV services onward to AvignonTGV or Nîmes. Fast international services from the Netherlands, Germany and Belgium are run by Thalys mainly to Paris, again with TGV connections onwards to Avignon and Nîmes. If you travel via Paris you need to transfer from Gard de Nord to Gard de Lyon to connect to TGV services going south, (though this also means that you can spend some time in Paris); if you travel via Lille it's just a simple platform change to connect to the TGV

services. You can book tickets in person, online or by phone all the way to Avignon or Nîmes with Eurostar or Rail Europe. If you are travelling from within France, see SNCF (look out for 'iTGv' and 'Prem's' for some good deals), and for travel from other European cities see Thalys, Rail Europe and Trenitalia. By Air

La Bastide Sainte Anne is conveniently located within reach of 4 airports:

Nîmes Airport (FNI) which is 30 km away from La Bastide Sainte Anne;

Ryanair flying into Nîmes with direct flights from London Luton (LTN), Liverpool (LPL) and East Midlands (EMA)

Avignon Airport (AVN) which is 40kms from La Bastide Sainte Anne, it's tiny yet quite smart and modern.

Flybe to Avignon with direct services from Southampton (SOU) and Exeter (EXT):

Air France also flies to Avignon airport from London City (LCY), and Heathrow (LHR), Aberdeen (ABZ), Birmingham (BHX), Dublin (DUB) and other departure points but require a change at Paris Orly.

Montpellier Airport (MPL) which is 70km from La Bastide Sainte Anne;

Flights to Montpellier are offered by Ryanair with services from London Stansted (STN), Dublin (DUB) and Glasgow (GLA). British Airways also fly from Gatwick (LGW) to Montpellier:

By Road

From Paris, Marseille or Montpellier:

Motorway A9, then take the exit for Remoulins.

From Remoulins, take the N86 to Montélimar.

At "Les Croisées", take the D19A to Alès & Uzes.

Then turn right onto the D892 to Mas Raffin.

Take the first left into Chemin de la Berrette, then first right into Chemin de la Garrigue.

La Bastide Sainte Anne is on the right.
